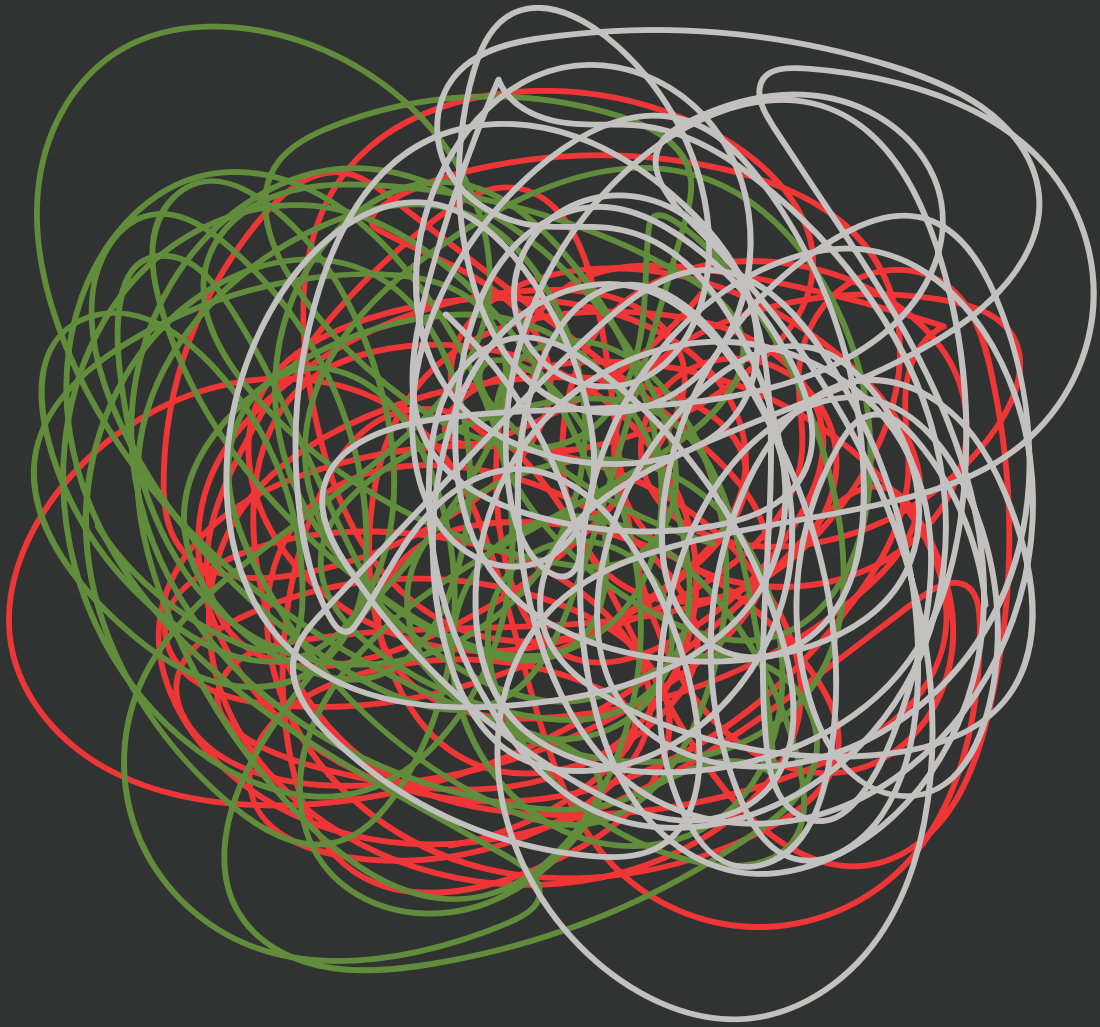

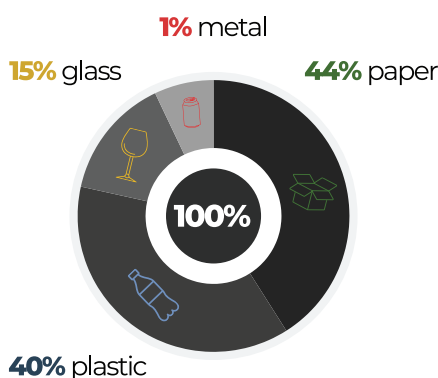

Projects overview

Recycle it!

"Recycle it!" is one of our key initiatives aimed at promoting proper waste management in Armenia and supporting the country in its transition from linear to circular economy.

The project focuses on keeping the recyclable waste out of the landfills, reducing the overall amount of generated waste, cutting down greenhouse gas emissions, minimizing environmental harm and increasing society's awareness level. It also aims to create business opportunities in waste management, create gender balance in previously male-dominated fields and support the organizations in meeting their Corporate Social Responsibility requirements to protect the environment.

- 84 Sorting Bins Installed
- 20 Environmental Trainings

THROUGH "RECYCLE IT!," WE HAVE STARTED PARTNERSHIP WITH OVER 800 ORGANIZATIONS, INCLUDING THE GOVERNMENT, EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS, LOCAL AND INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS ACROSS ARMENIA, WHERE WE HAVE INSTALLED OVER 3 500 SORTING BINS, CONDUCTED TRAININGS, MANAGED WASTE COLLECTION AND OTHER RELATED ACTIVITIES. THE COLLECTED WASTE IS EFFICIENTLY TRANSPORTED TO DESIGNATED RECYCLING SITES, CONTRIBUTING SIGNIFICANTLY TO OUR ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION EFFORTS. WE HAVE DEVELOPED A LARGE NUMBER OF EDUCATIONAL AND PROMOTIONAL MATERIALS WHICH HAVE LED TO MAJOR CHANGES AT NATIONAL LEVEL.

World Without Waste

The "World Without Waste" project is implemented jointly with Coca-Cola Hellenic Bottling Company Armenia company and Yerevan Municipality.

THE PROJECT IS AIMED AT IMPROVING THE WASTE MANAGEMENT SYSTEM IN ARMENIA, ENHANCING ARMENIA'S WASTE MANAGEMENT SYSTEM, FOSTERING ENVIRONMENTAL AWARENESS AMONG SCHOOL-AGED CHILDREN AND SUPPORTING LOCAL INITIATIVES FOCUSED ON PROMOTING A CULTURE OF WASTE COLLECTION AND RECYCLING.

Outcomes 2023:

- 30 Schools Participated
- 150 Sorting Bins Installed
- 40+ Environmental Trainings and Events

As part of the project, a variety of educational materials have been developed, including a workbook tailored for sixth and seventh-grade students, guides, and presentations designed for both students and teachers. Courses are conducted for sixth and/or seventh graders from all participating schools within the program, available in Armenian or Russian as needed. Furthermore, training sessions and consultations are arranged for teachers and school staff, alongside various other activities aimed at fostering the sustainability and growth of the project.

Promoting a culture of waste sorting among schoolchildren through educational programs is crucial for shaping societal behavior and ensuring the efficient functioning of waste management systems. In the last three years, the program has facilitated installation of sorting bins for plastic and paper waste in 150 public schools across Yerevan. To promote recycling among students, we host annual competitions and special events where winners are recognized and awarded. The objective is to inspire and incentivize active participation in the recycling process from an early age.

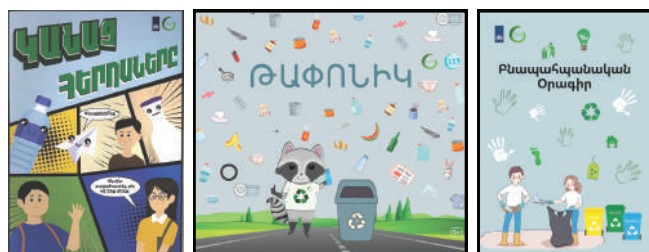
Tsaghkunk Project

“More effective sectoral service provision in Local self-government communities (LSGs): waste management in Armenian communities, phase 2- extension to Gagarin valley” project is implemented with the financial support of the Embassy of the Kingdom of the Netherlands in Armenia.

As a result of the absence of proper waste management mechanisms, the quality of public services provided to residents is reduced, which consequently negatively affects the process of good community governance. The installation of sorting bins within individual households in Tsaghkunk, rather than just public spaces, represents a novel approach in Armenian communities. This approach addresses the environmental challenges at the individual household level, emphasizing the significance of the issue and contributing to the development of new environmental behavior and culture.

AS PART OF THE IMPLEMENTED PROGRAM, OVER 200 HOUSEHOLDS, EDUCATIONAL, ADMINISTRATIVE AND BUSINESS ENTITIES IN TSAGHKUNK SETTLEMENT RECEIVED SORTING BINS FOR PLASTIC, GLASS AND/OR PLASTIC WASTE. FURTHERMORE, SORTING BINS HAVE BEEN IN SEVAN MUNICIPALITY AND FIVE NEIGHBORING COMMUNITIES OF TSAGHKUNK—ZOVABER, DDMASHEN, GEGHAVAN, GAGARIN AND VARSER—EXTENDING THE POSITIVE WASTE MANAGEMENT EXPERIENCE BEYOND TSAGHKUNK. THESE EFFORTS WERE GEARED TOWARDS INTRODUCING A NEW WASTE MANAGEMENT MECHANISM, ENCOURAGING CITIZEN ENGAGEMENT IN WASTE SORTING AND NURTURING A STRONGER SENSE OF ENVIRONMENTAL RESPONSIBILITY LEADING TO BETTER CITIZEN PARTICIPATION AND GOOD GOVERNANCE IN THE COMMUNITY.

The project will continue its operation in a sustained manner, aiming to reinforce and build upon the achieved results. New incentive mechanisms will be utilized to maintain the positive momentum within the community, motivating preschool children, school-age children and adults, irrespective of gender or occupation, to persist in waste sorting practices.

WITH POSITIVE FEEDBACK RECEIVED FROM THE BENEFICIARIES OF THE ACTIVITIES IMPLEMENTED IN 2023, WE ARE EXCITED TO CONTINUE OUR INTENSIVE TRAINING SESSIONS, INDIVIDUAL CONSULTINGS, DONOR MEETINGS, FUNDRAISING EFFORTS AND OTHER ACTIVITIES ALSO IN 2024 TO SUPPORT THE NGOS FROM ARTSAKH, FURTHERING OUR COMMITMENT TO CAPACITY-BUILDING AND TACKLING PRESSING COMMUNITY NEEDS.



Recognizing the challenges faced by forcibly displaced people from **Artsakh**, our team redirected its efforts to extend this impactful project to meet the needs of the similar organizations from Artsakh. The selected organizations from Artsakh are currently being equipped with skills in **Grant Writing, Strategic Planning, Donor Relations and Project and Financial Management.**

While initially this intensive training initiative targeted the less advantageous communities in Armenia with an objective to provide participants with invaluable insights, enhancing their capabilities for future endeavors.



Sub-grants for innovative projects in Vanadzor and /or Gyumri under ABC.GoV project

The project focuses on supporting "Vanadzor Municipality Staff" Community Management Institution within its ABC.GoV project. This support involves guiding the institution in developing, announcing and managing sub-grant calls. The sub-grants target non-profit organizations with innovative and sustainable project ideas in urban planning, waste recycling and transportation to be implemented in Vanadzor and/or Gyumri cities.



WITHIN THE PROJECT, WE COLLABORATE WITH THE ABC.GOV TEAM TO PROVIDE THEM CONSULTING SUPPORT ON THE PROCESS OF HOLDING A SUB-GRANTS CALL, DEVELOPING CORRESPONDING DOCUMENTS, REVIEWING AND SELECTING BENEFICIARY ORGANIZATIONS, CONDUCTING TRAINING AND STUDY VISITS WITHIN THE FRAMEWORK OF THE LOCAL "GREEN DEAL INITIATIVES" COMPONENT.

THE PROJECT IS CURRENTLY ONGOING, AND THE RESULTS WILL BE REPORTED UPON COMPLETION.

Outcomes:

- 20+ Consultancy Sessions
- 5 Sub-Grants Provided
- 28 Training Participants
- 3 Trainings Conducted





Composting in Baghramyan Community

In collaboration with the Embassy of Poland, Yerevan and PolishAid, we have initiated a project aimed at empowering the farmers of Baghramyan consolidated community to launch organic waste management activities at large. This project focuses on equipping farmers with essential skills, tools and materials needed for launching composting activities and fostering sustainable agricultural practices.

WITHIN THE PROJECT, PARTICIPANTS FROM THE EXTENDED COMMUNITY GAINED VALUABLE INSIGHTS AND ACQUIRED PRACTICAL COMPOSTING SKILLS. THE PROGRAM EXPOSED THE BENEFITS OF COMPOSTING FOR BOTH THE ENVIRONMENT AND AGRICULTURE, EMPHASIZING HOW ORGANIC WASTE CAN BE REPURPOSED THROUGH VARIOUS COMPOSTING METHODS.

Our experts, together with the local farmers, have tested various composting methods including composting with Californian worms, a beneficial addition to enhance the organic waste composting process.



Outcomes 2023:

- 153 Beneficiaries
- 7 Composting Sites
- 12 Tones of Composted Organic Waste

WHILE THE PROJECT WAS SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED IN 2023, WE REMAIN COMMITTED TO PROMOTING SUSTAINABLE FARMING PRACTICES FOR A GREENER FUTURE IN 2024 AND BEYOND.



Waste is The New Resource

A significant development in our waste management efforts was made possible through our partnership with JICA. Through this collaboration, we have acquired a pressing machine, enhancing our capacity to handle recyclable waste more efficiently. This acquisition enables us to compress waste materials effectively, facilitating their transportation to designated recycling facilities in a more sustainable manner. This initiative represents a substantial step forward in improving our community's waste management practices, promoting sustainability and environmental stewardship.



Waste Reforms in Armenia

Our collaborative effort with Coca-Cola Foundation, Coca-Cola Hellenic Bottling Company Armenia and representatives from the HoReCa sector of Armenia has led to the inception of the "Waste Reforms in Armenia" project under the World Without Waste initiative. As part of this endeavor, we have installed separating bins in food chains and food courts, undertook waste management activities during festival and other events, improving waste separation accessibility, conducted a large number of training sessions and engaging environmental events for the guests of HoReCa partners.



Environmental Olympiad-Competition

In collaboration with Adobe and other partner organizations, we are in the process of launching an Environmental Olympiad-Competition - which aims at improving STEM education in Armenia and focusing the students attention on environmental units with a broader vision to encourage the students to pursue careers in the field of environmental protection and management. The pilot project targetes 12-13-year-olds and focuses on enhancing their understanding of environmental issues, sustainable solutions and fostering environmentally responsible behavior.

The program will include activities focused on waste management, climate change and resource consumption to enhance participants' knowledge and create new interests. Upon the completion of the pilot phase in a selected consolidated community, the results will be summarized and presented to the corresponding state authorities to promote the launch of the nation-wide Olympiad.



Green Kalavan

Kalavan, a small settlement in Gegharkunik region with over 200 residents known for its untouched nature, sustainable living practices and eco-tourism opportunities, has embarked on waste sorting initiatives. In 2023 Kalavan's educational institutions, guest houses and government facilities were introduced waste sorting, upcycling and recycling practices. **This strategic move is aimed** at maintaining efficient waste management standards while also promoting the growth of green spaces and business opportunities within Kalavan.



The Green Hub

In collaboration with the local self government of **Baghramyan consolidated community** and with the support of **GIZ Armenia**, ISSD is actively engaged in advancing rural innovation, entrepreneurship and environmental well-being through the implementation of **"The Green Hub" project**.

As part of "The Green Hub" initiative, we are creating a dedicated co-working space to provide additional knowledge, tools and equipment to equip them to address local and global challenges.



"THE GREEN HUB" PROJECT IS DESIGNED TO EMPOWER THE RESIDENT'S OF BAGHRAMYAN COMMUNITY TO ESTABLISH SUSTAINABLE ENTERPRISES, FOSTER EQUALITY, CREATE NEW GREEN EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES, PROMOTE PROTECTION OF THEIR CULTURAL HERITAGE AND MORE.

Within this project, we are building a community of local youth, aiming to enhance their social skills while promoting green businesses and job opportunities in Baghramyan. Simultaneously, we will be recruiting and training members of Green Council, which will support the community in shifting from unsustainable to sustainable practices in different aspects and fields, and establishing strategic partnerships with the local self-government and other decision-makers.

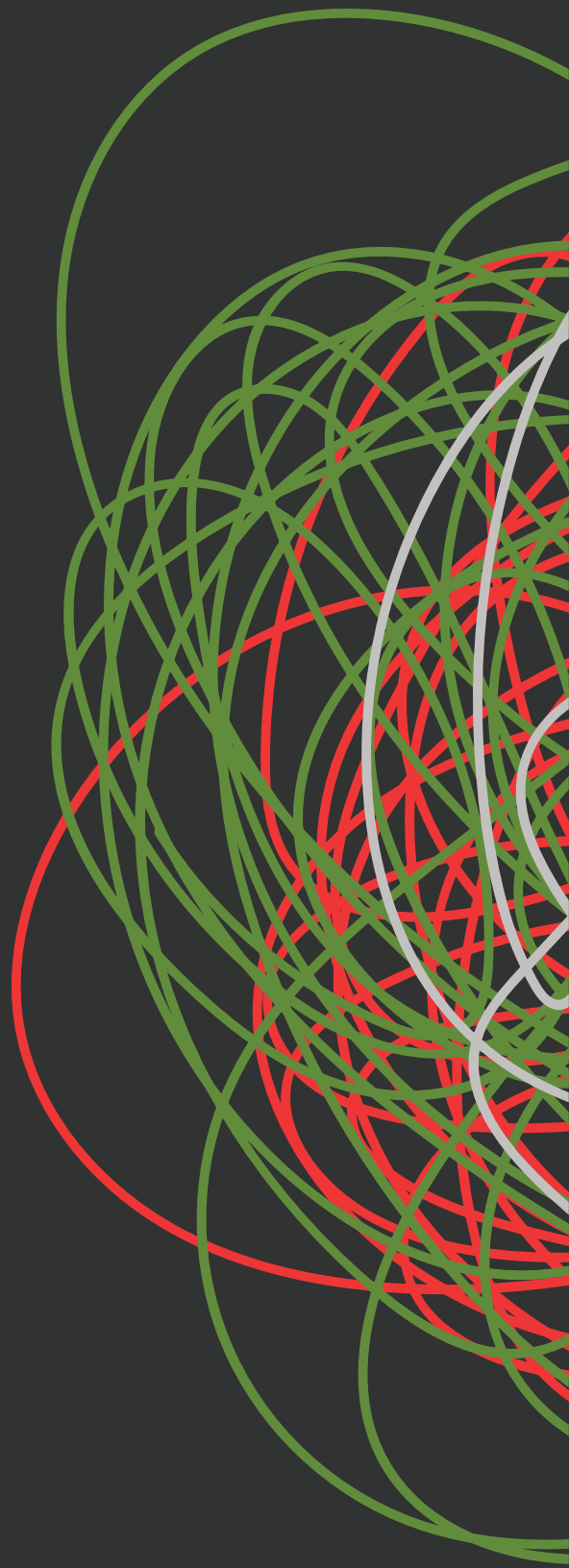
Outlook for 2024
